PARISH FEATURE & FOCUS

Acknowledging the allegation that he mingled with the sinners, Jesus outlines the three dimensions of repentance, by presenting three characters in this parable:

- 1) the repentant younger son,
- 2) the forgiving father, and
- 3) the self-justifying elder son.

Jesus includes these characters in the story to represent the scribes and Pharisees who began to complain, saying, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." We are not told how the elder son responded to his father's plea, or to his father's assurances of continued love, place, and inheritance ("All I have is yours").

Perhaps that is because Jesus meant the scribes and Pharisees to see that their own final response to the Father's love in sending Jesus had yet to be made, and that they still had time to "return home" to their Father in welcoming Him.
