### PARISH FEATURE & FOCUS

Pentecost literally means 50th. It is a feast celebrated on the 50th day after the Passover feast by the Jews and a feast celebrated on the 50th day after the feast of the Resurrection of Jesus by the Christians. The Jewish Pentecost was originally a post-harvest thanksgiving feast. Later, it was celebrated to remember God's covenants with Noah after the Deluge and with Moses at Mt. Sinai.

The role of the Holy Spirit in Christian life:

- 1. As an indwelling God, the Holy Spirit makes us Living Temples (I Cor 3:16).
- 2. As a strengthening God, strengthens us in our fight against temptations and in our mission of bearing witness to Christ by transparent Christian lives:
  - a) As a listening and talking God, listens to our prayers and enables us to pray, and speaks to us through the Bible.
  - b) As a giver of gifts, the Holy Spirit gives us gifts, fruits, and charisms.
- 3. We need to permit the Holy Spirit to take control of our lives:
  - a) By constantly remembering His holy presence and behaving well.
  - By praying for His daily anointing so that we Jun fight against our temptations and control our evil tendencies, evil habits, and addictions.
  - By asking His daily assistance to pray, listening to God through meditative Bible reading and talking to Him.
- 4. We need to ask the help of the Holy Spirit to do good to others and to get reconciled to God and others every day.

We radiate that Spirit and by our word and example invite others to share it. The gifts of the Spirit are not for us alone, they are to be shared. *Shalom!*
