PARISH FEATURE & FOCUS

What does the doctrine of the Blessed Trinity tell us about the kind of God we worship and what does this say about the kind of people we should be? On this, I have three points to share with you:

1. God does not exist in solitary individualism but in a community of love and sharing. God is not a loner.

This means that a Christian in search of Godliness (Matthew 5:48) must shun every tendency to isolationism. The ideal Christian spirituality is not that of flight from the world.

2. True love requires three partners.

You remember the old saying "Two is company, three is a crowd." The Trinity shows us that three is community, three is love at its best; three is not a crowd. We are made in God's image and likeness. Just as God is God only in a Trinitarian relationship.

3. The doctrine of the Blessed Trinity challenges us to adopt rather an I-and-God-and-neighbour principle.

I am a Christian insofar as I live in a relationship of love with God and other people. May the grace of the Holy Trinity help us to banish all traces of self-centeredness in our lives and to live in love of God. *Shalom!*
